Indicator 5: Percent of infants and toddlers birth to 1 with IFSPs compared to:

- A. Other States with similar eligibility definitions; and
- B. National data.

(20 U.S.C. 1416(a)(3)(B) and 1442)

Measurement:

- A. Percent = [(# of infants and toddlers birth to 1 with IFSPs) divided by the (population of infants and toddlers birth to 1)] times 100 compared to the same percent calculated for other States with similar (narrow, moderate or broad) eligibility definitions.
- B. Percent = [(# of infants and toddlers birth to 1 with IFSPs) divided by the (population of infants and toddlers birth to 1)] times 100 compared to National data.

Actual Target Data for 2007:

- A.: .97% exceeds comparison state average of 0.77%: Target MET
- B. .97% is below the national average of 1.06%: Target UNMET

Serving .97% of children birth to one year of age in FFY 2007 represents a .15% increase over children birth to one served in FYY 2006. South Carolina exceeds the comparison state average by .20% but is below the national average by .09%.
