Students eligible for 4K must provide evidence of either Medicaid, SNAP or TANF eligibility OR a documented family income at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty definition circulated annually by the US Department of Health and Human Services
OR are experiencing homelessness, transiency or in foster care.
