Priority Needs: Summary

Through a series of community convenings, a needs assessment and asset mapping process, the following needs were prioritized for Calhoun County.

1. Child Care Deserts

Calhoun County currently has one licensed childcare center.

2. Community Playgrounds

Calhoun County has three community playgrounds where none are in the town of Saint Matthews.

3. Economic Gaps

The economic gap between African Americans, Whites, and White (Non-Hispanic) in Calhoun County based on the median household income.

Overarching Measure(s) of Success

1. MORE CHILDREN ARRIVE AT KINDERGARTEN READY FOR SUCCESS

By 2026, the percentage of children who score at the highest level of the Kindergarten Readiness Assess will increase from 52% to 55%

2. INCREASE THE REACH OF FIRST STEPS SERVICES

By 2026, the percentage of children in need who are directly served by Calhoun First Steps will increase from 72% to 80%
