# Divine Redeemer Catholic School K4/First Steps Teaching Assistant Job Description

**General Job Summary:** Every employee of Divine Redeemer School is a religion teacher and expected, in word and behavior, to witness to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The K4/*First Steps* teaching assistant will be consistent at all times, in example and expression, with the tenets and morals of the catholic Faith. Under the direction of the Administration/Teacher, the teaching assistant will prepare activities, provide instruction and supervise the students and maintain program standards.

## **Primary Responsibilities**

- 1. Assists in implementing a program in accordance with the Diocesan, school, and *First Steps* Program guidelines.
- 2. Assists in providing a safe, nurturing, and positive experience for students.
- 3. Consider the individual child in relation to their culture and socio-economic background.
- 4. Assists in maintaining site discipline, open and effective parent communication, program improvement and school site personnel relations based on Diocesan and Divine Redeemer School guidelines and procedures.
- 5. Assists in developing and implementing effective, developmentally appropriate curricula.
- 6. Work cooperatively with Divine Redeemer School personnel and the teacher/administration to maintain a quality program.
- 7. Communicates K4/First Steps needs to the teacher/administration.
- 8. Maintains effective relationships with employees, parents, and students.
- 9. Assists in the set-up and arrangements of supplies and equipment.
- 10. Performs other related work as required by the position.
- 11. Comply with the Diocesan, Divine Redeemer School, and *First Steps* program policies and procedures.

### Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- 1. Must be willing to attain a working knowledge of Diocesan, school, and *First Steps* program policies.
- 2. Must have strong, appropriate communication skills.
- 3. Must possess and demonstrate appropriate interpersonal skills.
- 4. Under the general supervision of the teacher/administrator, must be able to perform duties such as preparing materials, assisting students individually, and in small groups.
- 5. Must exercise patience, tolerance, and objectivity when working with individual or groups of students,

#### **Education/Training Requirements**

- 1. Must possess, at minimum, a high school diploma or its equivalent.
- 2. Must have one year of documented experience working with children under five years of age.
- 3. Must have completed the Early Childhood Development Credential (ECD) 101 or enroll and complete this course within twelve months of the teaching assistant contract award.

## **Working Conditions**

- 1. Position involves mobility, bending, carrying, and lifting (under 25 lbs.)
- 2. Must be willing to work outdoors.
