Priority Needs: Summary

Through a series of community convenings, a needs assessment and asset mapping process, the following needs were prioritized for Barnwell County. See our full needs assessment here: https://www.scfirststeps.org/media/t2cdi1be/barnwell-county-fy24-26-needs-assessment.pdf.

1. Childcare

Survey participants indicated that Barnwell County has a significant lack of quality, affordable childcare. The town of Williston is a childcare desert.

2. Community Resource Connections for Families

Respondents report that it is difficult for families to locate the appropriate resources when in need.

3. Transportation

Survey respondents indicated that transportation is a major hurdle in accessing resources for their families.

Objectives

1. FAMILIES HAVE AFFORDABLE AND ACCESSIBLE CHILDCARE

Families can access and afford high quality early care and education programs that meet the needs of their children and families.

2. FAMILIES CAN ACCESS COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Families with young children will have knowledge about and be able to access all publicly-funded programs, services, and resources for which they and their children are eligible.

3. FAMILIES HAVE ACCESS TO TRANSPORTATION

Families with young children will be assisted in locating and accessing local transportation options to obtain services both in Barnwell County and in the surrounding areas.

Objective One: CHILDCARE

ERADICATE THE CHILDCARE DESERT IN WILLISTON, SC

Barnwell County First Steps will establish a child care center in Williston, SC.

SMART GOAL(S)

1. Barnwell County First Steps will partner with the Barnwell Consolidated School District to open a child development center at Kelly Edwards School during FY'24..

ADD CHILDCARE SLOTS ACROSS BARNWELL COUNTY

Increase child care slots in Barnwell County.

SMART GOAL(S)

- Barnwell County First Steps will support other childcare providers in adding child care slots to their centers to increase capacity for children to be in care across Barnwell County by the end of FY'26.
- Assist new providers in becoming established childcare centers. We will assist one provider and have an additional center open by the end of FY'26.

- Community individuals beginning to open their centers.
