PDG Needs Assessment 2019

Three strategies (January-June 2019)

- Stakeholder Meetings (n=440)
- Survey—Parent/Caregiver and Organizations (n=3,114/2,680 used)
- Focus Groups—First Steps Partnerships (n=1,495)

Identified overall priorities in three areas

- Early Learning and Development
- Health and Wellbeing
- Family and Community

PDG Needs Assessment 2020-2023

Four strategies (April 2020-April 2023)

- Parent/Caregiver Survey (n=2,727)
 - Identified level of need based on 2019 priorities and strategic plan
- Parent/Caregiver Interviews (n=38)
 - Triangulated survey findings, sought strategies to meet needs
- Early Childhood Educator Survey Pilot (n=353)
 - Identified needs of educators; educators' perception of children's needs
- Stakeholder Meetings (n=158)
 - Shared findings, sought strategies to meet needs
