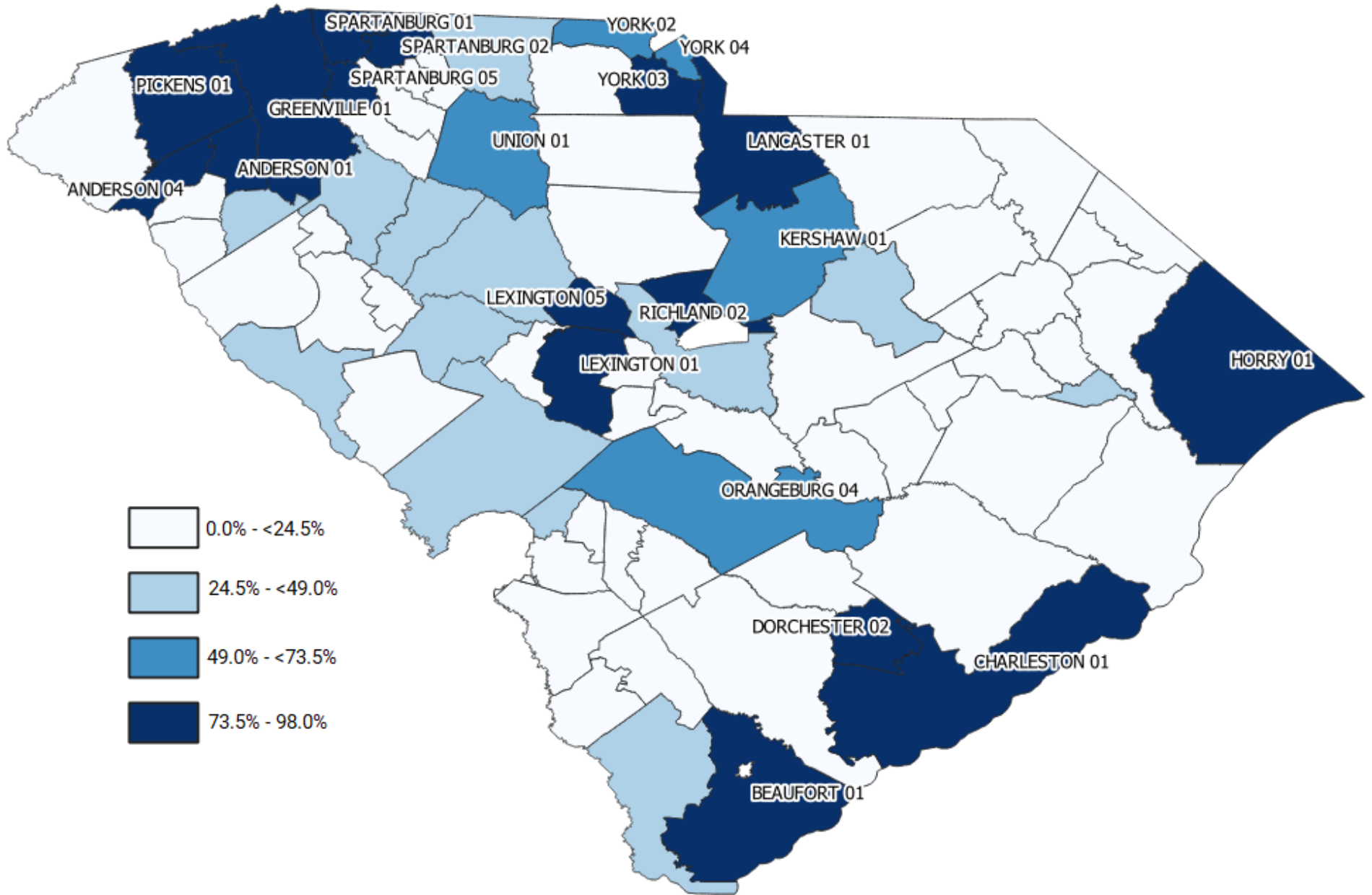


Estimated Percent of Four-Year-Olds in Poverty Not Served by CERDEP or Head Start
