

Quick Start Guide

ReadyRosie is a birth through 3rd grade cohesive family engagement resource that facilitates family partnerships for powerful student outcomes. Your families will receive short, modeled moment videos via text or email each week. These videos model games and activities they can enjoy with their child to support the learning at school.

Connect With Your Families



Go to readyrosie.com and click "sign in." Enter your district email and your password can be whatever you would like it to be the first time you log in. That will now become your password.



2 Introduce Families to ReadyRosie

Once signed in, click on the "Resources" tab on the left, once there click "Introducing Families to ReadyRosie." The registration flyer under "Invite letters" is a good overview.



3 Create a Classroom and Invite Your Families

Click "Classrooms"

Click "Add a new class"

After you create class, click "Manage Classroom"

Click "Invite Families"

Fill out the information

Click the button at the bottom to schedule your invitations to go out

Manage Your invitations

Your families will need to accept the invitation to join ReadyRosie. You may need to edit and/or resend some invitations after a week or so.

Click "Classrooms" on left-hand side

Click "Manage Classrooms"

Create Custom Playlists

ReadyRosie sends a playlist of videos out each Monday. However, you can create your own playlists to support the learning taking place in your classroom. Take Home Learning to the next level! Click "Playlists" on the left-hand side

Click "Add Playlist"

Give your playlist a title, short description, choose the class to send it to, and select your videos to send.

Follow the prompts to translate your playlist if needed

Save and schedule your playlist to go to families!

 (example: Maria could identify the numbers 0-7, we will keep working on the rest!)



Communicate with Families

Families can comment on videos, providing feedback on how the activity went. You will receive a notification and can comment back for personal, one to one, communication.

- Click the envelope in the top right-hand corner to read video comments from your families.
- 2. **Look** for families with a number next to their name for comments and click on their name.
- 3. After reading **comment**, scroll to the top and reply.
