#### **EVALUATION FOCUS AND TIME FRAME**

Examine reach and impacts of child care scholarships

• FY18 through FY22



#### **CONTEXT**

- SCDSS receives federal block grant funding for child care scholarships
- First Steps local partnerships support and facilitate access to scholarships
- Two types of scholarships
  - purchased from SCDSS
  - "in house" via local resources
- Most families also engaged in other First Steps programs/services



#### CONTEXT

- First Steps scholarships unique
  - Focus on child developmental and academic outcomes
  - Funding does not supplant other programs/services
  - Use of scholarships with other evidence-based (EB) programs
- As of FY22, First Steps partnered with SCDSS directly to administer the scholarships
  - for families also enrolled in other First Steps EB programs

- What is the reach of the First Steps Scholarship program?
  - Children
  - Counties
  - Childcare providers
- What are the key characteristics of children and families receiving scholarships?
  - Risk factors
  - Developmental status
  - Involvement in other First Steps programs

### PRELIMINARY FINDINGS: REACH AND CATEGORY OF SCHOLARSHIPS FY18-FY22

Across the five-year evaluation period, there were 2,131 scholarships provided










#### SCHOLARSHIP TYPE BY COUNTY FY18-FY22





#### **SCHOLARSHIPS BY FY AND COUNTY**






#### RISK FACTORS FOR POOR SCHOOL PERFORMANCE






## PROTECTIVE FACTORS AGAINST POOR SCHOOL PERFORMANCE




#### **PROVIDER BY FISCAL YEAR**







#### Number of Licensed Child Care Facilities





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
#### **SCHOLARSHIP TYPE BY PROVIDER**








# OVERALL ABC QUALITY LEVEL OF PROVIDERS
