to display census tracts that are considered a child care desert ("Yes"), not a child care desert ("No"), or both ("All"). The map and the statistics listed under "Selected Geography" will change according to what you select.

Map Tools: if you hover over the top left of the map, a navigation bar will appear that will allow you to interact with the map in different ways, like zooming in and out or panning around.



Base Color of Map: the base map is the proportion of children under age 6 who are in poverty (<100% of the federal poverty level). This scale will change dynamically with the map view, but the darkest color will always indicate the highest proportion

5 Point Data: the points on the map represent locations of child care and school facilities. The colors correspond to the facility type as displayed in the legend. If you click on a color in the legend, only that facility type will be highlighted. To deselect, click the color again.

Tooltips: if you hover over different features of the map, text boxes with more information will appear. If you hover over a census tract, details about the county and tract will appear. If you hover over a provider, details about the provider's location and grades served (if a school) or capacity and ABC Quality level (if a child care).



Tableau tools: you can share, print, or make the map full screen using these buttons in the bottom right of the screen.
